



COVID INFORMATION

We will be following the most recent order put into place by Governor Greg Abbott for the State of Texas at the time of the race.

Packet Pick Up:

If at all possible, please make arrangements to pick up your packet on Thursday or Friday at the designated Packet Pick Up locations to eliminate Day of Race lines.

Day of Race:

- This is an outside event, masks are encourage but optional. If you choose to be wear a mask please be mindful of our deaf and hard-of-hearing friends and choose a clear panel mask or a face shield.
- We will be dividing start times into four groups to eliminate to allocate more space between runners.
- This race is chipped timed, therefore staggered start times do not make a difference on placement. Everyone is timed individually when they leave the gate and cross the finish line.
- Each group will start in cueing area in the plaza and will have a safety captain move you to the gate when your group is ready to run.
- Gate will be divided into times into runner times to eliminate crowding.

Chip Timed:

We will be using disposable chips that will be applied to your bib prior. No chip pick up or removal is required.

Awards:

Awards will be announced at 10:00 am.. You do not need to be present to receive award and will be contacted by email the following week about mailing your medal to you if you prefer to leave after you run.

Deaf & Hard of Hearing Medals:

We will be giving deaf and hard-of-hearing medals. If you prefer not to come to the front for a photo op and medal, please find a captain who is passing them out individually.
